The Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Hydropower Renewable Energy Development (KHRE), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Package 1 - CIVIL WORKS – Water Conveyance Structure (weir, diversion structure, tunnel etc), Access Roads and Bridges of 88 MW Gabral Kalam Hydropower Project located in District Swat of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province (KP). For this contract the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.
2. The PEDO through PMO KHRE now invites sealed Bids from the following prequalified eligible Applicants for the Works, including, but not limited to the below:

A. Construction of Civil Works:

- Diversion weir/Concrete dam
- River diversion works during construction
- Connecting channel
- Sandtrap
- Inlet pond
- Headrace tunnel
- Access tunnels
- Surge shaft
- Pressure shaft
- Permanent and Temporary bridges
- Temporary and Permanent access roads
- Protection works
- Allied works including landscaping etc.

- B. Design, Supply, Installation and Testing of Hydraulic Steel Works:
- Gates, Stop logs, Trash racks, Cranes, Steel liner, Manifold etc.

Quantities, location of project and other necessary information is described under Section VII “Project Description” of the Bidding Documents.

Construction Duration shall be 4 years.

A margin of preference shall not be applicable.

Prequalified Applicants are:

- i. M/s Dogus (Turkey) and Descon Engineering Limited (Pakistan)- Joint Venture;
 - ii. M/s China Gezhouba Group Company Limited (CGGC)-China;
 - iii. M/S China Road & Bridge Corporation (CRBC)-China and China Anneg Group First Engineering Bureau (CANFE)-China Joint Venture; and
 - iv. M/s Sinohydro Corporation Limited-China.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-” Fourth Edition, November 2020 (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all prequalified eligible Bidders.
 4. Prequalified eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Office of Director Project (KHRE) and inspect the bidding document during office hours 0900 to 1700 hours at the address given below.
 5. The bidding document in English may be purchased by prequalified eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Pakistani Rupee 30,000/- or equivalent USD. The method of payment will be through cashier’s check, pay order or bank draft drawn on a scheduled bank of Pakistan in favour of the “Head PMO, Construction of 88 MW Gabral Kalam Hydropower Project”. The document will be sent by airmail or courier as appropriate or it may be picked up from the Employer’s address given below.
 6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 1500 hours December 19, 2022. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below at 1500 hours on December 19, 2022.
 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of USD 1,400,000, or its equivalent in another freely convertible currency calculated on the base of the selling exchange rate of the National Bank of Pakistan on the date of 28 days before the date of bids opening.

8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
