MINUTES OF THE PRE-BID MEETING HELD ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2025

17MW Ranolia Hydropower Project, District Kohistan Lower"

The pre-scheduled pre-bid meeting was held September 16, 2025 in Main Committee Room of PEDO House, under the chairmanship of Project Director Rehabilitation and Restoration of 17 MW Ranolia Hydro-Power Project. The meeting was attended by the members of the PEDO procurement committee and the representatives of the potential bidders. List of Participants is attached as **Annexure-1**.

The Chair welcome the participant of the meeting after the introduction of the meeting participants, followed by a detail presentation, delivered by the Team Leader of the Consultants JV, on the project with special emphasis on the project components included in the Civil Works LOT-II. Appendix M and N to Bid (Financial Capabilities of the Contractor, Experience Record, Personnel Capabilities and Equipment Capabilities of the Contractor) were also explained in detail. The chair explained the site conditions, its access to the project components and the emphasis on the urgency for timely completion of the project. The chair suggested that all the participants/ bidders may visit the site for better estimation of the cost and preparedness. It was explained that the bidding is based on the National Competitive therefore the foreign bidders are not entitled to bid.

During the questions and answers session the participants raised various questions and the following points were discussed in details.

9	Transportation of Materials and Labour:	At least four of the identified sites are accessible only through cable cars. This extraordinary requirement means that both construction materials and labour must be transported via cable cars, significantly escalating costs. The additional burden of this logistical arrangement will have a direct impact on the bid percentage. You are requested to kindly include/allow the Contractors to include the cost of at least 4 Nos of Cable Cars, and this shall be added as BoQ items to the Bidding Documents. This will allow all the Contractors to quote their bid prices for these extremely important additional items in their respective bids	Clarification Bidders are advised to acquaintance themselves with the site condition to have a comprehension of the site, particularly the transportation of material to construction site. Transportation of material to the construction site shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. The bidder in his "Method of Performing the Work (Appendix-F to Bid)" shall clearly and with sufficient details, describe the method he shall adopt for the purpose at his cost. The viability of the method shall be duly evaluated in the evaluation of bid and will be subject to approval of the Employer.
